Howdy Y'all,

Hey y'all. Here's an update on the drive to replace our old – oh so old – steel. Most of our 20 year old targets are ready to be put out to pasture.

We're closing in on the final opportunity to have your name go down in history....or at least have your initials on a target for the next 20 years. If you've shot with us recently, you've enjoyed the sweet clang of the new tombstones, coffins, and stop signs.

Our deadline for those interested in helping is March 15th. If you've been thinking about it, now is the time to make your pledge....operators are standing by....

Our goal of purchasing 3 sheets of 3/8 AR500 steel will yield approximately 36 new targets of various size and shapes. We expect to have them for our 2020 Annual.

The cost for each target is approximately \$125 – depending on shape and size.

The funds will come from several sources.

1. Steel Sale: While our old targets are pitted, dished out and have minimal clang, they are perfect for use by the typical backyard shooter that just wants to go out and throw a few rounds down range at steel. For that reason, we will be selling off all of the old steel. Our shooters will have first dibs.

2. Sell Scrap: The steel that is not purchased by our shooters will be sold off for scrap.

3. Target Sponsors: Here's your sign!!! Or at least a chance to sponsor one. We are asking our shooters to donate \$100 per target. You will receive two 1" initials of your choice cut through the target on a lower corner. (Example: My targets will have a MM in them for Misfire Mordecai.) You are welcome to buy more than one if you wish. If you wish to split a target the cost is \$60 per person. The little extra covers the cost of two sets of initials on one target.

4. Club Funds: Our monthly raffles and shooters fees provide a small source that will be used to make up any deficits between our other fund-raising efforts and the cost of the targets. The shooters from the Concealed Pistol/Home Defense Match is contributing their annual intake to help.

If you're interested in buying old steel or sponsoring a target - contact me or see me at the shoot. We hope to order the first sheet of steel after this month's shoot. We already have three targets sponsored and several promises to sponsor one within the next few months.

To alleviate the problem the board voted to grant the Cowford Regulators exclusive rights to the 6 bays on range #5 during our match day. We will not longer have to deal with non-cowboys during our matches.
