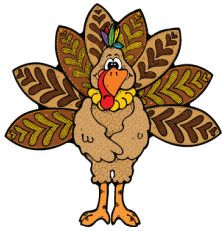

Turkey Shoot Month



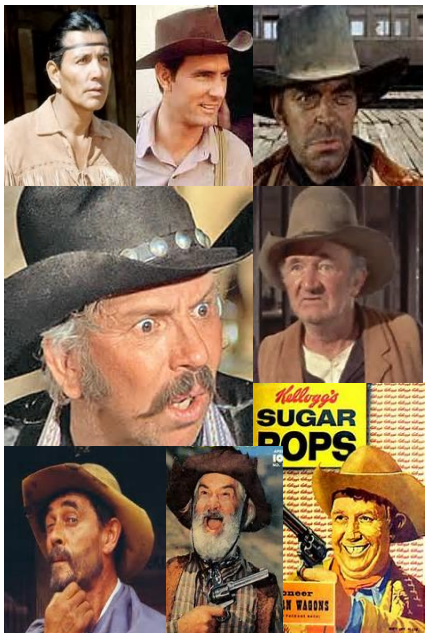

3rd Sunday from now on. Get your gear and come out. Great for the family. See the flyer attached here.



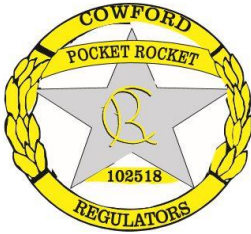
