To All Cowford Regulators; During our last shoot it became apparent that the Cowford policy regarding re-shoots needed to be clarified so that everyone understands when a re-shoot will be allowed. One re-shoot per shooter will be granted at monthly matches only. No re-shoots will be allowed during the April Annual

Re-shoots will be allowed when:

- A rifle or pistol malfunctions (including squibs) **AND** there are unfired rounds left in the weapon that cannot be fired
- A shotgun malfunctions that prevents all rounds for the stage from being fired
- Any of the above conditions occur **AND** the Shooter stops in mid sequence because of malfunction and declares a malfunction to the RO

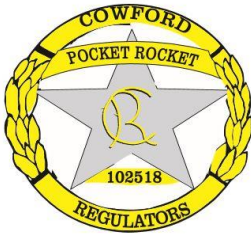
When the above occurs, the RO will instruct the shooter to take their guns to the unloading table to clear all guns before re-loading for a second attempt at completing the stage.

Conditions that are not considered a malfunction when:

- A single round does not fire but weapon is still functioning
- A round or rounds are jacked by mistake

- The shooter grounds the malfunctioning weapon, does not declare a malfunction and continues the stage with the remaining weapons. Sheriff Misfire Mordecai
